Rust is a disease of slow growing turf. Rust is most noticeable on lawns that are newly planted and malnourished, both favoring the development of this turf problem. The good news is that rust is seldom a serious problem, it's just aesthetically unpleasing. From a distance, rust-infected turf has a yellow orange cast. Close inspection of the rusted leaves reveals numerous yellow-orange pustules on the blades of grass.

Walking though grass that has rust may result in a rusty, orange color on one's shoes or lawn mower.

Maintaining a healthy lawn is the most effective and efficient method of control. At Weed & Feed we fertilize the turf with a high dose of nitrogen, and we recommend you should avoid watering in the evening. The grass will eventually outgrow the disease.
